Terms of Use for the "Baschweri" Rope Garden

- Before entering the rope garden, all users must read through these Terms of Use and acknowledge them by signing this document. **In the case of children under the age of 14, the supervising adult must first discuss the Terms of Use with the user and confirm his or her agreement by signing this document.**
- Children's course: For children 4 years and up who are no taller than 135 cm (4'5"), weigh a maximum of 40 kilos (6.3 stones) and who are accompanied by a supervising adult.**
- Course 1-6: The minimum height is 135 cm (4'5") and maximum weight is 120 kg (265 lb). Children under 12 may only take part together with an adult. Children aged 12 to 14 must be supervised by an adult. Young people as of 14 to 18 must show proof of consent from a parent or guardian.**
- Use of the rope garden involves risks and is undertaken entirely at your own peril. Clothes may be dirtied or damaged. **The rope garden is unsupervised; the sole function of the park staff is to provide instruction, monitoring, and assistance. Visitors enter the rope garden parcours independently, at their own risk and responsibility.**
- Insurance is the responsibility of the user.**
- The rope garden is open to users who do not suffer from any illness or other physical or mental condition that could endanger their own health or that of another person while using the park. Persons under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or strong medication are not permitted to use the rope garden.
- No items that may pose a danger to the users themselves or to other persons (jewelry, cell phones, cameras etc.) may be taken into the rope garden. **Long hair and loose clothing must be secured.** Clothing: casual/athletic, sneakers or hiking shoes.
- Users must participate in the entire theoretical and practical safety lesson before using the park. The user should raise and clarify any points that are unclear during the lesson.** All instructions issued and decisions made by the rope garden's employees are binding. Violations of or failure to comply with safety requirements may lead to a user being expelled.
- Equipment on loan (helmet, climbing harness, etc.) must be used strictly in accordance with directives/instructions and is to be returned voluntarily once the reserved period of use has ended. Any damage to the equipment must be reported to the rope garden staff.
- Throwing or leaving objects or any form of trash on the ground is prohibited. Please use the trash receptacles provided. Smoking, eating, or drinking on the parcours is not permitted.
- Use of the rope garden is limited to three hours (subject to further payment). Users are not entitled to any refund of the admission price if the staff is forced to close the park due to acts of nature/force majeure.**
- Aletsch Bahnen AG does not assume any liability for any damage sustained (directly or indirectly) in connection with use of the rope garden. Aletsch Bahnen AG specifically rejects any such liability in the event a user circumevents, fails to comply with, or violates these Terms of Use.
- The jurisdiction and venue is Brig. These terms are governed solely by the laws of Switzerland.
