



# Aletsch Glacier Round Trip

The most spectacular glacier hike in Switzerland

## Program:

We meet at 8:15 a.m. at the Bergsteigerzentrum Aletsch at the Volken Sport Store and Café in Fiesch, which is directly situated in the valley station of the gondola FieschFiescheralp. From here we take the gondola to the Fiescheralp at 2222m. There we start our hike via Tälligrattunnel to the Gletscherstube at Märjelensee at 2350m. There our mountain guides distribute the technical equipment for the glacier tour.

After a short break, we continue towards the Aletsch Glacier. There you will be roped on. Before we start with the approx. 2 - 3 hours round trip on the glacier, the mountain guide will orient you about the correct behavior on the glacier. After 1½ hours of hiking and some interesting explanations and stories about the Aletsch Glacier, we will have a lunch break on one of the large medial moraines. After the lunch break we will continue to be on the ice for about 45 minutes before returning to the Gletscherstube. If you like, you can spend the rest of the time at Märjelensee. Otherwise the hike goes back to the gondola at Fiescheralp. We will be back in Fiesch at approximately 4:00 p.m.

## Realization as of 6 participants

Minimum age 10 years

## Requirements:

Sufficient physical condition for a total walking time of **6 - 7 hours** is required. No mountaineering experience is required, but you should be **sure-footed**. The tour is suitable for all ages and technically not too difficult. Nevertheless, it is an alpine mountain hike. Children should be at least 10 years old.



### Equipment:

It is essential to keep the weight of the backpack to a minimum!

- Hiking or trekking shoes (no running shoes)
- Hiking gear (incl. long pants and jacket)
- Gloves and hat/headband
- Sunglasses
- Food and drink

Technical equipment (climbing harness and crampons) will be provided free of charge.

### Insurance:

An adequate accident insurance is the responsibility of the participant. We recommend that you take out a cancellation insurance. Please note our **general terms and conditions** that are published on our homepage and in the current annual program.
