

## Steingräbji Apartment – a brief guide

### Wi-Fi

The router is in the hallway. Connection instructions are provided there. Connection via password Sarihund21

### TELEVISION

Only possible via HDMI or mobile phone app. HDMI connection cable is the responsibility of the tenant.

### White amplifier box

This is a Bluetooth amplifier.

### Heating

During the transition period, please only use electricity when necessary. There are radiators in the hallway, bathroom and bedroom. The large mirror in the living room is also a radiator and can be switched on above the mirror.

### In winter with fireplace

See separate instructions on the small coffee table.

There is a spiral for towels in the bathroom. When you turn it on, it is enough for the entire bathroom. The additional electric heater is useful in winter; you can set a minimum temperature.

### Piano

You can use it. Please leave it clean.

### Rubbish

An orange rubbish bag is provided. On Wednesdays, rubbish is collected from the dog container downstairs early in the morning. Otherwise, you can dispose of rubbish at the Tunetsch restaurant.

The same applies to glass. Or speak to Diego.

### Car park

The car park is at the bottom of the road, just above the old schoolhouse, now the headquarters of the

municipal administration and Aletsch Tourism. If there are several vehicles, the cheapest parking space is below the municipal administration, at Mrs Stucky's. The municipal administration is

the large brown chalet below the car park.

Hiking and skiing.

Of course, the entire Aletsch region is available for hiking.

Enjoy the mountain world.

But there are also beautiful hiking trails from Mörel, e.g. to the chestnut trail to Bitsch or via the Tunetsch restaurant to Grengiols. And there are numerous other attractions in the valley. These include, of course, Brigerbad, Stockalper Castle, a trip to the Simplon Pass or one to Goms. Goms is a very extensive valley for hiking.
